Re: FCC Proposes 2010 Annual Regulatory Fees

The FCC proposed its schedule of annual regulatory fees for fiscal year 2010. The fees by type of mass media license are listed below.

Unlike prior years when digital TV licensees did not have to pay annual regulatory fees, the FCC plans to collect the annual regulatory fee from all digital full-service stations, and the "digital-only" exemption will no longer apply. For LPTV, Class A, and TV translators, a fee will be assessed for each facility operating either in an analog or digital mode. If they operate in both analog and digital mode as a simulcast, a single fee will be assessed.

Note that the FCC will be sending reminder post cards as it has done in prior years, but that post card will not include fees that might be due on any auxiliary licensees such as RPUs or STL links. The FCC proposes to discontinue those mailings in 2011, and seeks comments on its plans.
