The National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) recently filed a formal request to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to reconsider its decision to reinstate the so-called FM Duplication Rule. Brad Deutsch was recently quoted in [Radio and Television Business Report](#) and featured on the [InFocus](#) Podcast, presented by dot.FM, to discuss the FM Duplication Rule.

This controversial decision, finalized in a June 2024 order, has sparked significant criticism from radio industry stakeholders. The reinstated rule restricts commonly operated commercial FM stations in the same market area from having more than 25% overlapping content in their broadcasts. The original rule was repealed in 2020, but the FCC's June 10, 2024, vote saw a return of this regulation in a 3-2 party-line decision.
