The program will present an overview of the recently issued Bench Guide for Addressing Bias in the Courts produced by the Supreme Court Committee on Women in the Courts. It will address how gender bias affects litigants and attorneys and how attorneys and judges can address gender bias in the courts. Attorneys' ethical and professional responsibilities relating to bias will also be discussed.

Ms. Kaller is co-Chair of the Bar Education Subcommittee of the Supreme Court Committee on Women in the Courts. Her practice focuses on commercial litigation.
