Recent developments will include the "Radburn Law," intended to enhance participation in community association elections, which was signed into law on July 13, 2017; the September 14, 2017 Palisades at Fort Lee Condominium Association decision interpreting the statute of limitations in construction defect litigation; the application of the New Jersey Consumer Fraud Act and corporate veil piercing to community association construction defect litigation; and pending legislation.

Ms. Li focuses her practice in real estate, with a concentration in planned real estate development law and condominium law.
