He has been on the cutting edge of developments in the environmental law sector since the 1980s. He has extensive experience related to the cleanup and redevelopment of contaminated properties including brownfields, environmental compliance and insurance issues, institutional and engineering controls, assessing and negotiating liability under federal and state Superfund laws, resolution of environmental issues in bankruptcy proceedings, litigation arising from those issues, and the emerging field of sustainable development and green building. For over twenty-five years, Mr. Farer has written and lectured extensively on environmental issues in New Jersey and nationally. He was the first New Jersey lawyer to be appointed a Fellow in the American College of Environmental Lawyers
