- Private Well Testing Act and well water agreements
- What to look out for when buying in an association
- An update on the status in the courts and procedures and new legislation impacting landlord tenant law
- Real estate litigation; actions to quiet title
- Recognizing and avoiding ethical dilemmas

Mr. Goodman focuses his practice in commercial litigation, with a particular concentration in real estate and real estate brokerage issues and municipal law.
