The program is scheduled for Tuesday, June 25, 2013 from 9:00 am - 12:30 pm at the NJ Law Center in New Brunswick, NJ.

The seminar will explore the relationship between the developer and association - from the proposed development of a community, to the transition of control from governing board to homeowner, to the sell-out of the community. Attendees will learn about the structuring of communities, the significance and drafting of documents, financial accounting and management concerns in the development and transition process, requirements of governmental agencies regulating the communities, the rights and obligations of the developer and the association, and the remedies available to the developer and the association.

Ms. Li is a member of the firm's Real Estate Department, and serves as chair of our Planned Real Estate Practice Group.
