- Preparing the space for the tenant's occupancy which party will be responsible
- The Tenant's use whether it will be broad or limited
- Which party is responsible for complying with laws
- · Utilities and other building services, and who's providing them
- The parties' ongoing maintenance, repair, and alteration rights and obligations
- Premises liability, insurance, and indemnity risk allocations
- Securing the tenant's (and the landlord's) performance
- The parties' respective default remedies
