Partner Marc Gross Saves BP Gas Stations From Termination

Marc J. Gross, Esq., an attorney at the Roseland, N.J. law firm of Greenbaum, Rowe, Smith & Davis LLP, obtained a significant ruling from a federal Judge on Wednesday, September 14, 2011, precluding BP Products North America from terminating all of its New Jersey franchises.

Gross filed suit on behalf of the Franchises on October 7, 2009 in *Alboyacian, et als. v. BP Products North America, Inc.*, Civil Action No. 2:09-cv-05143. The lawsuit arose after BP announced that it would not renew its franchise agreements with a group of New Jersey service station operators when their contract terms ended. Faced with the loss of their livelihoods, the station owners banded together, hired Gross and filed suit against BP, asserting that New Jersey law obligates BP to maintain the franchise relationships so long as the station owners complied with the terms of their agreements. On September 14, 2011, the U.S. District Court agreed and ruled in a landmark decision that Gross' clients had an absolute right to renew their agreements.

In what appears to be a case of first impression, United States District Judge William J. Martini granted summary judgment to the station owners, confirming that New Jersey law protects franchisees from termination by way of non-renewal. The Court rejected BP's argument that it need not renew the agreements because they did not expressly provide for renewal. The case will have a far reaching impact on all franchise owners. In fact, Judge Martini's decision firmly establishes that absent a prior breach by a franchise owner, every New Jersey franchisee is entitled to a renewal of their franchise agreement, as a matter of law.
