

Steven Nudelman Appointed to Second Term on New Jersey Supreme Court Committee

Steven Nudelman, a partner in the firm's Litigation Department, has been appointed to a second consecutive term on the New Jersey Supreme Court Committee on Complementary Dispute Resolution (CDR) for its 2019-2021 term. The appointment is effective September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2021.

The Committee on CDR oversees and implements the rules governing the Supreme Court's CDR practice, which includes mediation, arbitration and settlement proceedings. The Committee evaluates these programs and the standards for selecting and training mediators and arbitrators. CDR programs are available to help parties resolve disputes in a variety of actions, including family law and matrimonial disputes, personal injury claims, landlord-tenant disputes and small claims matters.

Also effective September 1, 2019, the Supreme Court will merge the activities of the Committee on CDR with its Arbitration Advisory Committee, which examines and makes recommendations to the Court regarding rules, policies and procedures governing the Court's arbitration program. Additional details on this merger will be provided by the Court shortly.
