

Greenbaum Partner Wins Burton Award For Legal Achievement In Writing

Greenbaum, Rowe, Smith & Davis LLP partner **Alan S. Naar** won a 2008 Burton Award for Legal Achievement for Legal Writing Award for his chapter, "Understanding The Benefits And Risks Of Alternative Dispute Resolution," that appeared in the Inside the Minds series book, Mediation and Arbitration Best Practices: Leading Lawyers on Successfully Resolving Disputes through Alternative Dispute Resolution (Aspatore, 2007). He is a certified arbitrator for the U.S. District Court, District of New Jersey and a certified arbitrator of the American Arbitration Association. He is a trustee of the Association of the Federal Bar for the State of New Jersey and a former Member of the Executive Committee of the Federal Practice and Procedure Committee of New Jersey State Bar Association.
