Greenbaum partner **Steven Nudelman** will serve as the Presiding Judge for the finals of the virtual International Mock Trial (IMT) tournament scheduled for Friday, December 20 and Saturday, December 21, 2024. The tournament has 40 teams of 8th through 12th graders, from various regions throughout the United States, Canada, China and Hong Kong. Over 100 judges have participated in the tournament, ranging from practicing attorneys to alumni and participants in American Mock Trial Association competitions. The primary purpose of IMT, which is in its third year of existence, is educational, since they charge no fees and their competitions are conducted over Zoom Videoconference.
