Jeffrey Izzo has been chief of the Political and Economic Section at the U.S. Consulate in Toronto since September 2011. Since joining the Foreign Service in 2000, Mr. Izzo has served in Washington, D.C., and at four embassies worldwide, including as deputy chief of the Energy Unit in Baghdad, Iraq, from 2010 to 2011 and as chief of the Political and Economic Section at Embassy Luanda, Angola, from 2008 to 2010. He served as energy officer at the Bureau for Economic and Energy Affairs from 2006 to 2008, where he covered Canadian energy issues and led the Department of State's Presidential Permit process for cross-border crude oil pipelines. He also served as political-military officer at Embassy Budapest, Hungary, and consular officer at Embassy Kingston, Jamaica. A graduate of the University at Albany with a B.A. in English literature and geography, Mr. Izzo is the recipient of multiple superior and meritorious honor awards from the Department of State.
