This project was one of the first municipal projects in the state, if not the first, to take advantage of recent statutory modifications exempting public construction projects with project labor agreements from the multiple prime contractor requirements of the Wicks Law. This structure enabled the project to come in on time and below budget. We also served as State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) counsel for this project and successfully defended the county in litigation brought on environmental and state law grounds.
