

FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION WILL BAN MOST NON-COMPETE CLAUSES IN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACTS

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The Federal Trade Commission recently issued a final rule broadly banning the majority of non-compete clauses in employment contracts, which are typically meant to stop employees from working for or starting with competing companies within outlined geographic and time limits.
