The Anti-Indemnity Train Continues

Amundsen Davis Transportation Alert January 15, 2016

On December 22, 2015, Ohio became the latest and 43rd state to adopt an antiindemnification provision for transportation agreements. Effective March 21, 2016, the bill voids any section of a transportation contract that indemnifies the promisee from liability when the loss was caused by the promisee's actions. This statute does not apply to the UIIA.
