Obtained Dismissal of a Putative Class Action Brought Against an Indiana Financial Institution Challenging its Assessment of Bank Fees

Amundsen Davis obtained dismissal of a putative class action brought against an Indiana financial institution challenging its assessment of bank fees. The team obtained a favorable ruling on a motion to dismiss a state court action brought by a customer, alleging the bank charged improper NSF fees (multiple fees for the same item) and deceived customers in violation of the Indiana Deceptive Consumer Sales Act, which resulted in a successful early resolution of the matter.
