Caleb Burns Discusses Obama Cabinet Member's Use of Private Plane for Official Business

Caleb P. Burns, a partner in Wiley Rein's Election Law & Government Ethics Practice, was quoted in an article published today by *Politico* about Commerce Secretary Penny Pritzker's use of her private jet for official business.
