Michael Toner was interviewed by CNN on political fundraising in the 2012 election cycle.

CNN reported that political experts estimate that \$6 billion dollars will be spent during the 2012 presidential election and that an appreciable amount of that money has been made possible by the *Citizens United* Supreme Court decision. But in the aftermath of the *Citizens United* ruling and with the record amounts of money being spent in the 2012 presidential race, Mr. Toner noted that the issue of money and politics is not new.
