

Megan Brown Previews Supreme Court's New Term

In a radio interview with CNN affiliate WEBY in Florida, Megan L. Brown, a partner at Wiley Rein, previewed the Supreme Court's new term, discussing cases ranging from reargument in *Kiobel v. Royal Dutch Petroleum*, involving the extraterritorial reach of the Alien Tort Statute, to criminal procedure cases like *Florida v. Jardines* and *Florida v. Harris*, addressing dog sniffs and searches under the Fourth Amendment. Ms. Brown addressed an important case involving the ability of plaintiffs to challenge national security legislation, *Clapper v. Amnesty Int'l*, in which Ms. Brown filed a brief on behalf of six former United States Attorneys General. She also discussed notable cases that may come before the Court in the near future.
