Wiley Receives NABA's International Achievement Award

Washington, DC—Richard E. Wiley, managing partner of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP, has been named the recipient of the North American Broadcasters Association's (NABA) International Achievement Award.

This award recognizes Wiley's commitment to NABA's goals and principles and his accomplishments as a leader in the broadcast industry, notably his role as chairman of the Federal Communications Commission's Advisory Committee on Advanced Television Service, which established the digital and high definition television transmission standard that was adopted by the FCC in 1995.
