Washington, DC – Megan L. Brown, partner in Wiley Rein’s Privacy & Cybersecurity and Telecom, Media & Technology practices, will be a featured speaker at the 2019 South by Southwest (SXSW) Conference, as part of the panel titled “Exploring Frameworks to Advance Consumer Privacy.”

The March 9 discussion in Austin, Texas, will review the types of collected data that are targeted by malign actors, as well as the fallout and lessons learned from past breaches that compromised the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of data. Panelists will also assess new frameworks for consumer privacy.
