Delacourt testified today before the Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation, at a hearing entitled “Abusive Robocalls and How We Can Stop Them.” The hearing examined issues related to malicious spoofing and abusive robocalls that are designed to defraud consumers, and the steps government and industry are taking to protect consumers.
