Washington, DC–Wiley Rein LLP garnered a top spot on *Washington Business Journal*'s'Corporate Philanthropists' list for Midsize Companies for the second year in a row, in honor of the firm's commitment to the community as measured by volunteer hours and charitable donations.

Wiley Rein was the only law firm to earn a top rating for corporate philanthropy in the "midsize" category, defined as companies in the DC metropolitan area with 100 to 999 employees. The firm ranked third among midsize companies for employee volunteer hours, and fourth for metro-area giving. The firm gave \$1.1 million in donations to Washington, DC-area charities, and in total, contributed \$1.5 million to more than 500 charitable organizations nationwide.
