The USMCA replaced the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) in 2020 and provides a framework for resolving trade disputes between the U.S., Mexico, and Canada. As an alternative to judicial review by domestic courts, the USMCA permits independent binational panels to hear appeals from final antidumping and countervailing duty determinations. Ms. Toledano is one of 34 people named to the U.S. roster for USMCA Chapter 10 disputes.

"I'm honored to have been selected for inclusion in this distinguished list," said Ms. Toledano. "I look forward to serving in a process that plays such an important role in international trade and diplomacy."
