Reminder: Deadlines Approaching for Channel Sharing Stations

October 11, 2017

Several deadlines are approaching in the coming months for television stations that submitted a successful bid to relinquish their spectrum in the broadcast television incentive auction and either: (i) entered into a pre-auction channel sharing agreement; or (ii) indicated an intent to channel share on their incentive auction applications ("channel sharee stations").

- Channel sharee stations must discontinue operations on their pre-auction channel by <u>January 23, 2018</u>.
- If a channel sharee station intends to channel share with another station on or before January 23, 2018, it must file an application for a construction permit 60 days before it intends to begin sharing (and in no event later than <u>November 24,</u> <u>2017</u>).
- If a channel sharee station desires to continue broadcasting on its pre-auction channel after January 23, 2018, it should file a request for a waiver of the discontinuance deadline as soon as possible (and in no event later than <u>November 24, 2017</u>). Stations that do not expect to file an application for a construction permit to channel share by November 24, 2017, must request a waiver of the construction permit deadline no later than <u>October 25, 2017</u>.
